## The National Association of Women Artists and the Women Painters of Washington join forces for the exhibition Women Artists Coast to Coast - EAST

The National Association of Women Artists (NAWA) and the Women Painters of Washington (WPW) partnered for their first bicoastal exhibition this past October In Seattle. That exhibition, *Women Artists Coast to Coast - WEST* was the first of two exhibitions of exciting and visionary artworks by women to celebrate NAWA's recent 125th birthday and WPW's 85th.

The second of the two exhibitions, *Women Artists Coast to Coast - EAST*, will open on February 28 at the Prince Street Gallery in New York City

Both NAWA and WPW were founded with the mission of helping women artists exhibit their work at a time when they were barred from full participation in a male-dominated art world. As philanthropist Elisabeth Murdoch reported in Artnet.News in March of this year, "When I began to have informal conversations with female artists, I found that a surprising number of them voiced concerns about attitudes toward the female

artist." Organizations like NAWA and WPW have come a long way, but their efforts to empower, promote, support and encourage women artists remain invaluable.

These important exhibitions will also give the viewers the rare chance to consider the similarities and differences in the styles and subject matter presented.

Women Artists Coast to Coast-EAST will exhibit 80 juried works, 40 from each group, to be presented at the Prince Street Gallery, 503 West 25<sup>th</sup> Street, New York City, from February 28 to March 25, 2017. The New York reception will be held Thursday, March 2, from 5-8 pm. Margaret M. O'Reilly, Executive Director and Curator of Fine Art, New Jersey State Museum, was the juror the Women Artists Coast to Coast - EAST exhibit for the NAWA members, while Patricia Rozvar of Patricia Rozvar Gallery in Seattle juried the WPW members' works.

Art enthusiasts on both coasts are encouraged to attend and celebrate the art of some of the country's finest women artists working today.
