- at the Benjamin Rosenthal Library, Queens College, April- June. Asher led a group of art students from Columbia University, Hunter and Queens Colleges to India during January Intersession in a course entitled "Portraits of India". The objectives of the course included exploring India through the theme of portraits: of people, landscapes, and inner impressions. The class included visits to artist studios, museums and galleries, schools and a rural village school. Asher is the Director of Art Education and Assistant Professor in the Dept of Secondary Education and Youth Services at CUNY Queens College.
- Katie Weiss' recent activities included a residency at the Vermont Studio Center in March 2012 and her work has been exhibited in several group shows, including "The Nude in Art" at 1275 Studio Gallery in Fairfield, NJ and the Watchung Art Center, Watchung, NJ. She had solo shows at the Mendham Public Library in Mendham, NJ and the Gilbert Gallery at Miss Porter's School, Farmington, CT. Ms. Weiss was an art teacher at Flushing High School from 1984- 2007.

Dodd recently had a retrospective exhibition at the Kemper Museum of Art in Kansas City, Missouri. The show traveled to the Portland Museum of Art, Portland, Maine. Dodd's work is represented by the Alexandre Gallery, NYC. She attended Cooper Union and is a member of the American Academy of Arts and Letters and the National Academy of Art. - In response to two of **Roslyn Fassett's** paintings, "Etu Cloth" and "Nsibidi Script," in "Art and the Human Form: Concept, Costume and Beyond" at the Blue Door Gallery, Yonkers, NY, in April 2012, Marshall Debruhl wrote in the catalogue, "Yes, Darkness and to see, Light, and with this light a flow of color, dark reds, purples rich and sensual. Here is the stillness of women caught in a moment, turned toward light. A yearning for meaning beyond words, clothes them in patterns and images brought from the textiles of Mali and Nigeria."

- Three times a year **Wendy Shalen** offers a week-long work-shop: "French Inspired Drawing" at The Art Students League of New York and the Drawing Study Room of The Metropolitan Museum of Art. Students spend two days at the museum working from original master drawings in graphite on paper and three days working from the nude model at the League using French drawing techniques. The next "French Inspired Drawing" workshop is November 18- 22nd, 2013.

■ The New York Society of Women Artists presented "Synergism", from June 16 through July 6. Seventeen member artists created a lively dialogue in a spectrum of styles with works in 2 and 3-dimensional media. Synergism represents the cooperative spirit among the group members where each artist's talent, artistic and organizational, results in unique exhibition opportunities.

Founded in 1925, NYSWA devoted itself to the promotion and exhibition of avant garde women artists, at a time when women were severely under-represented in museums and galleries. NYSWA limits itself by charter to 60 members.

- Working on Paper August 2013- gallery group show with a variety of approaches to works on paper, including sketchbooks.
