8th National Juried Show

Prince Street Gallery's 8th National Juried Show will take place February 2 - 27. Juror is **Graham**Nickson, Dean of the New York Studio School.

Graham Nickson was born in England and completed his studies at Camberwell School of Arts and Crafts (BA) and his Master's degree at the Royal College of Art in London, 1972. He has resided in New York City since 1976. He is the recipient of the Prix de Rome (1972-74), The Harkness Fellowship at Yale University (1976-78), the Guggenheim Fellowship (1989), and the Ingram Merrill Fellowship (1993). His work is in the permanent collections of many institutions including the Metropolitan Museum of Art, NY; The Museum of Modern Art, NY; Fogg Art Museum at Harvard University, MA; The Albright Knox Gallery, NY; the Neuberger Museum of Art, NY; the Frye Art Museum, Seattle; The Lillehammer Art Museum, Norway; and the Boca Raton Museum of Art, FL. He has been a faculty member and Dean of the New York Studio School of Drawing, Painting and Sculpture since 1988 and is the originator of the internationally renowned "Drawing Marathon".

New Gallery Artist

■ Patricia Bouley was born in Kansas and lives and works in New York City. She received a BS from Southern Connecticut State University and studied at L'Académie de la Grande Chaumiére in Paris. Bouley's work is in the permanent collections of the Cooper Hewitt Museum of Design, and the Museum of Art at the Rhode Island School of Design. Her graduate studies in decorative arts and her work in textiles as an art director and color specialist led her to a full time career as a painter. Patricia's most recent solo exhibition, "The Mind's Eye" was at the Center for Arts Education in New York, March 28-April 1, 2015. Her work has been featured in group exhibitions at AIR Gallery and the Phyllis Harriman Mason Gallery, both in New York City. Patricia has been a visiting artist at Rhode Island School of Design, Parsons The New School for Design, and the Fashion Institute of Technology.

The Trenton Artists' Workshop Association Inc., is a nonprofit organization founded in 1979 by Latta Patterson and Dr. Mary Tatum Howard (and friends) to promote the arts in the greater Trenton, NJ Area. Since its inception, membership in this arts collective has grown to over 350 professional artists, art educators, art students, and patrons of the arts. TAWA served as a catalyst for several city festivals — which brought together regional musicians, writers and theater artists — and assisted in the creation of the city's first professional theater.
