Robyn Whitney Fairclough

In this current exhibition, **Robyn Whitney Fairclough** revisits her exploration of the figure which offers infinite visual and psychological intrigue for both herself and the viewer.

Fairclough's paintings transport you into the emotional world of the figures she paints. The beach scenes and familial portraits we are used to seeing from Fairclough have transformed into a more wistful world of isolation – a story of solitude, disconnection, and inner reflection. Her use of space is compelling, creating striking compositions with broad and evocative brushstrokes. A fragment of the female experience is explored through these works in which Fairclough captures complex emotional beings using bright colors and blank faces. These works guide your eye and transport you into the mind of a woman who is searching for what has been lost.

This is Fairclough's second solo show at Prince Street Gallery. She has exhibited twice in two person shows at the gallery as well as in numerous group shows. The David Findlay Gallery in NYC represented Fairclough for ten years where she had three solo shows before it closed in 2009. The Barbara von Stechow Gallery in Frankfurt Germany has represented her for fifteen years. She will be having her third solo exhibition at the von Stechow Gallery in October 2020. In addition, Fairclough is represent by The Southport Galleries in Southport, CT. Her work has been featured in numerous curated group shows in CA., CT., NH., NY., PA., and Vermont as well as in Art Fairs in Palm Beach, Florida and Frankfurt and Cologne, Germany.
